The deadline for applications is February 24, 2023.

- The file format should be Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx).
- The length of the article, typed single spaced in 14-point Times Roman font and justified; with margins of 2 cm all around, is from 15,000 to 25,000 characters with spaces.
- Pages are not numbered; paragraph indent is 1.25 cm.
- It is necessary to distinguish between a long dash (–) and a hyphen (-).
- The list of references should be compiled in alphabetical order.
- References are given in the text in square brackets indicating the ordinal number of the source in the list of references and the page number [1, p. 28].
- Automatic footnotes are not allowed; paragraph spacing is not allowed.
- The reference list under the heading "**References**" follows the main text of the article in double spacing. It should be arranged in accordance with the rules of bibliographic description:

- The initials and the surname of the author are to be placed in the right-hand corner in bold italics; in the next line – city, country (in brackets); the title of the article is to be placed in the center of the page in bold capital letters. For example:
